



els in the corridor are arranged with bench seating. The corridor leads to a rooftop healing garden, a place of quiet and restful reflection for patients, family, and staff.

The new addition's exterior was clad in brick, cast stone, and glass curtainwall and features a large cantilevered drop-off canopy. The architectural style of the new tower was designed to complement and enhance that of the existing campus. The tile floor of the grand lobby is illuminated by natural light that warms the contemporary space. A stone water fountain and planter anchor the large room and are central in the lobby. The two-story space features a ceiling finished in stained maple wood detailed in a radial pattern. A mezzanine overlooks the space and utilizes warm,



wood finishes and a railing that is a blend of stainless steel, wood, and translucent panels containing dried grasses. Lounge seating echoes the crisp lines of the room with an organic-leaf-patterned area carpet for the seating group.
