

Rockdale Medical Center places on Quality Honor Roll

Rockdale Medical Center (RMC) has been named to the Georgia Hospital Association's (GHA) Partnership for Health and Accountability (PHA) Quality Honor Roll. RMC is one of 23 hospitals in Georgia to achieve this recognition. The honor roll is based on clinical data provided by the federal Centers for Medicaid and Medicare Services (CMS), which administers the nation's Medicare and Medicaid programs. The data was collected from October 2006 to September 2007.

"This is a great accomplishment for Rockdale Medical Center," said Joseph Parker, president of GHA. "This recognition further underscores the commitment of the RMC staff

to ensuring that every patient receives the best, most effective health care possible."

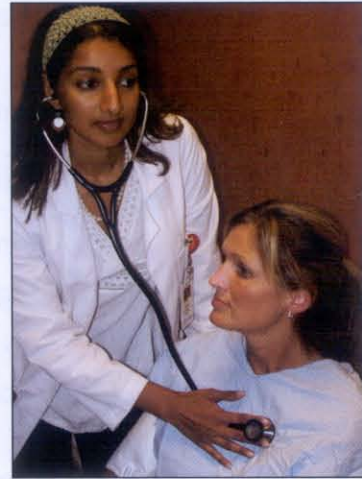
The CMS data details how well a hospital's caregivers adhere to a list of 10 Appropriate Care Measures (ACM) which are the clinical processes of care that are known to be the most effective methods of treatment for patients who have suffered heart attacks, heart failure or pneumonia. For instance, a recommended treatment to help prevent a heart attack is to take aspirin either before or upon arrival at the hospital. A hospital's adherence to these recommended clinical practices usually leads to better outcomes.

In addition, RMC was

recently recognized by the Georgia Medical Care Foundation along with three other hospitals in Georgia for sustaining success with Appropriate Care Measure Compliance. The average PHS scores for the State of Georgia in 2007 was 81.4 percent and Rockdale Medical Center achieved 99.92 percent.

"It is our goal to ensure that each of our patients receives the right care at the right time and this recognition validates this," said Michael Potter, Chief Executive Officer of Rockdale Medical Center. "This honor is a tribute to the hard work and dedication of our staff who are constantly working to make excellent care even better."
